## Gratitude Tour

Pay homage to the bold, courageous women who not only made their homes in the Finger Lakes, but also made history here. This five-day tour takes you from Syracuse to Rochester to celebrate and explore the lives of our nation's most notable women.

### Day 1 – Start in Syracuse and end in Auburn

Matilda Joslyn Gage Home located at 210 E. Genesee St, Fayetteville, NY 13066 is her home turned museum. Learn about the founding member of the National Women Suffrage Association, Matilda. Then head to over to Auburn and walk the grounds of Fort Hill Cemetery and pay your respects to Harriet Tubman, Martha Coffin Wright, Lydia Ann Moulton Jenkins and more. Find it at 19 Fort Street, Auburn, NY, 13021. While in Auburn order from Gretchen's Confections (ask about the Tubman Truffle) 27 E. Genesee St, Auburn, NY 13021 - online/phone orders only.

### Day 2 – Explore Auburn

There is a reason Auburn is History's Hometown. Visit the **Harriet Tubman National Historic Park** (180 South Street) and the **Seward House Museum** (33 South Street) and discover the link between the families! Make time for lunch at **Prison City** where Dawn has pour all of herself into making vibrant brewpub with American bites in an idustrial-chic space at 28 State St, Auburn, NY 13021.

### DAY 3 – From Auburn head to Aurora and then end in Seneca Falls

In Aurora you'll find the **Inns of Aurora** (391 Main Street, Aurora, New York 13026) where you can take walking tours and explore their ever growing outdoor activities! Fufill your appetite with lunch at **1833 Kitchen & Bar**, 391 Main Street and drive over to **MacKenzie Childs**, 3260 State Route 90, Aurora, NY 13026. Shop their stunning show room and take in the beautiful views of the lake. Next up, the **National Womens Hall of Fame** at 1 Canal St, Seneca Falls, NY 13148.

### Day 4 – Enjoy your day and end in Seneca Falls

Fuel up for your big day with breakfast at **Cafe19 Revolutionary**, 20 E Bayard St, Seneca Falls and prepare for your day of exploring the **Women's Rights National Historical Park**, **Waterfall at Declaration Park**, **Elizabeth Cady Stanton home**, **M'Clintock House** and the **Hunt House "When Anthony Met Stanton"**

### Day 5 – Head to Victor and end in Rochester

Visit **Ganondagan State Historic Site in Victor** at 7000 County Road 41 (Boughton Hill Road), Victor, NY 14564 and end your 5 day excursion by visiting **Susan B Anthony's grave at Mt. Hope Cemetery in Rochester**, 1133 Mt Hope Ave, Rochester, NY 14620 and end by visitnig **Susan B Anthony's house** 17 Madison Street.
